HAITI APPEAL



Following the horrendous news about the Haiti earthquake two sixth form pupils at Ysgol Brynrefail, Greta Fflur Jams and Enfys Elen Roberts, decided to organise events to raise money for the appeal.

With the support of the Head teacher, both girls attended a meeting of the Caernarfon Rotary Club, held at Bontnewydd, to outline their plans. To launch the appeal a cheque for £250 was donated by the school's Sixth Form Society, and further £250 was donated as the contribution from the School Fund.

On Wednesday 27th January 2010, during a parents evening at the school refreshments were served by a group of sixth form girls with the proceeds going to the fund.

On Friday 29th January 2010 a non uniform day took place ably supported by staff and pupils. The sixth form girls baked cakes and biscuits that were sold during morning break. Two pupils from year 8 completed a 'Sponsored Silence'.

A grand total of £1831.52 was raised by the school towards the appeal. Three 'shelter boxes' will now be sent, in the name of Ysgol Brynrefail, to the residents of Haiti.
